Blacklands Farm at Wainscott, under the ownership of former rider Richard Whitebread, has been a venue in regular use by the club since the 1950s, it is sad for us to announce that it appears we are losing this little venue. Medway council have earmarked the land for housing development as part of their local plan. Thank-you to the Whitebread family for letting us use this land for so long!

Positive news, thanks to another club member, we have been able to bring online another bit of land near the village of Bredgar (Nr Sittingbourne) and will be working to develop this into a long-term relationship.

As its 100 years of Bexley, we have been digging through the archives and old trophy boxes that have been hidden in peoples lofts for donkeys years, a good number have been uploaded to the website. Part of this mission has been to try and fulfil the history of our Langmaid trial, it is our oldest and most prestigious annual event, a list of past winners is overleaf, but any help you may be able to provide in filling in the blanks will be greatly appreciated.
